**Public Comments:**

John Wojick, Kingsland

Mr. Wojick stated that while he understands millage increase he has concerns with the types of development he sees around the area. He explained that he has observed people buying smaller properties and setting up travel trailers on them for a residence. He stated his concerns are that these smaller parcels will decrease surrounding property values and he felt it was something the board should take into consideration.

Chairman Starline asked Mr. Wojick to speak to Commissioner Casey after the public hearing concludes.

Brett Paldalski, Woodbine

Mr. Paldalski asked is there a purpose to the meeting. He stated that he would like to see the funding for the Joint Development Authority dropped and the one (1) mil of tax allocated to that department removed. He stated that it was time the Joint Development Authority stand on their own feet. He stated that he would like the Board to evaluate the validity of the Spaceport project and is it even viable.
