

**CAMDEN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
TUESDAY OCTOBER 7, 2003 6:00 PM  
WOODBINE, GEORGIA**

**A regular meeting of the Camden County Board of Commissioners was held on Tuesday, October 7, 2003, at 6:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room at the Courthouse in Woodbine, Georgia.**

**Present: Commissioner David L. Rainer; Commissioner E.B. Herrin, Jr.; Commissioner Stephen L. Berry; Commissioner Sanford S. Feller; County Manager Charles D. Akridge; and County Attorney Brent Green. Commissioner Preston Rhodes was absent.**

**Chairman Rainer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.**

**Reverend Jim Johnson, Agape Christian Fellowship, delivered the invocation.**

**Chairman Rainer led the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**The roll call indicated all Commissioners were present excepting Commissioner Rhodes.**

**AGENDA AMENDMENTS:**

A motion was made by Commissioner Feller, seconded by Commissioner Herrin and voted unanimously to add the brick façade of Fire Station #12 bid award to the agenda as Item C.

Commissioner Feller made a motion to add consideration of a Town Hall meeting on October 16, 2003, at the Camden County High School to discuss the realignment of the health care system. The motion failed due to the lack of a second.

Commissioner Berry stated, and Chairman Rainer agreed, a Town Hall meeting on this matter is in order, but not at this time.

**MOTION TO ADOPT THE AGENDA:**

Commissioner Feller made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Herrin and voted unanimously to adopt the agenda as amended.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 16, 2003:**

Commissioner Feller made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Herrin and voted unanimously to approve the September 16, 2003, regular meeting minutes.

**B. County Manager's Report**

- Mr. Akridge reported the following:

The Department of Natural Resources approved the Flea Hill Water System plan, but the plan approval is contingent upon the County meeting certain criteria.

The Coastal Georgia RDC, First Annual “Coastal Showcase” will take place on Jekyll Island, November 20 – 22, 2003. This event presents an opportune time to meet with state legislators.

Fire Chief Danny Daniels advised the Commissioners the All Hazards Council Grant has been increased to \$237,235.00.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **A. Red Ribbon Week Proclamation**

Commissioner Feller made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Herrin and voted unanimously to proclaim October 23 – 31, 2003, as Red Ribbon Week.

Mr. Akridge read the Proclamation into the record, a copy of which is incorporated into and made a part these minutes.

### **B. Acceptance of right-of-way deeds from residents of Winding Road**

A motion was made by Commissioner Herrin, seconded by Commissioner Berry to accept the right-of-way deeds for the Winding Road paving project from the following individuals, and said deeds are incorporated herein by reference:

*Charles Mungin*, (Parcel B) for 0.15 acre, dated August 22, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records;

*Christian Harvest Ministry*, (Parcel C) for 0.11 acre, dated August 22, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records;

*Ruthella Sanders*, (Parcel D) for 0.11 acre, dated September 17, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records;

*Shirley Joann Watson and Susan T. Brim*, (Parcel F) for 1.28 acres, dated September 26, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records;

*Ardenia Mungin*, (Parcel H) for 1.38 acres, dated August 22, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records; and

*Bradley and Mendy Langley*, (Parcel I) for 0.05 acre, dated September 16, 2003, and recorded in the Camden County Public Land Records.

Commissioner Feller inquired about the funding for this project, and Mr. Larry Lampe, Road Department, advised the funding would come from S.L.O.S.T. funds.

Mr. Akridge informed the Commissioners, upon confirmation from the Road Department, there are no infrastructures located on the conveyed properties.

**C. Bid award for the brick façade of Fire Station #12**

Mr. Harvey Amerson, Facility Maintenance, advised the Commissioners the low bid for the labor of placing the brick façade on Fire Station #12 came from J. C. Taylor Construction in the amount of \$10,620.00, and he recommended accepting this bid.

Upon questioning by Commissioner Berry, Mr. Amerson informed the Commissioners this bid was for the labor costs of bricking the front, two (2) sides, and part of the back of the fire station. Mr. Amerson stated the material costs would be approximately \$4,000.00.

Commissioner Berry made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Herrin and voted unanimously to accept the low bid from J.C. Taylor Construction in the amount of \$10,620.00 for the labor of placing the brick façade on Fire Station #12
