Tax Relief Legislation for Camden County

Woodbine, GA – March 6, 2009: After receipt and review of Senator Jeff Chapman’s Press Release proposing to enter a Bill to provide relief for homeowners in St. Marys, the Camden County Board of Commissioners Office contacted the Mayors of St. Marys, Kingsland and Woodbine to discuss a possible resolution to propose such Bill for each of the cities. Following numerous telephone conversations and meetings, County Commission Chairman David L. Rainer, in cooperation with Mayors Eskridge, Smith and Clark, prepared a letter to Senator Chapman requesting his presence at a work session on Tuesday, March 17, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss the possibility of legislation being introduced for the City of St. Marys, the City of Kingsland and the City of Woodbine. The letter also requests that Senator Chapman provide a copy of the draft Bill to each of the mayors and chairman prior to its submittal for review.
