Approve as submitted.

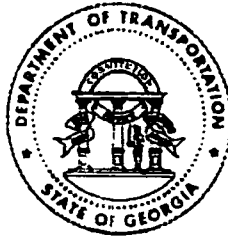

RE: LOCAL ASSISTANCE ROAD PROGRAM

Dear Chairman Rainer,

In anticipation of possible funding for the 2010 Local Assistance Road Program (LARP), it is time to begin developing a program reflecting the resurfacing needs in your local roads/streets system. To be eligible for LARP, local governments must be in compliance with the Local Governments Audits Act and with the State Service Delivery Act by January 1, 2010.

The Department strongly encourages local governments to use the Department's electronic submittal process; however, it is not mandatory at this time. To use the web-based electronic application program, please go to URL http://prd1-larp-web.dot.state.ga.us/ctsa_larp to log in using your user-id and password to register and begin your application process. You have been assigned the user-id CAMDENCOUNTY, and password 6MYBWINB. There is an animated tutorial accessible through the Help button within the LARP program that will assist you in preparing your on-line application.

If you do not submit your list on-line, you must complete the attached Certificate of Ownership and Maintenance Agreement form and mail it along with your list to your District Engineer. Regardless of how your LARP list is submitted this year, a map showing each priority must be mailed to Mr. Glenn Durrence, District Engineer, at P.O. Box 610, Jesup, Georgia 31598. As always, please do not submit any roads/streets which have been recently selected but not yet resurfaced. Your priority list should show the termini of the roads/streets requested.

All LARP applications must be received by August 1, 2009 to avoid delays in completing your resurfacing needs in 2010. Thank you for your attention and cooperation in this matter, this will allow the Department to assist you in your road and street improvements.

There is one check that we recently received that requires a budget amendment to recognize the additional revenue for the current fiscal year. This amendment will affect the general fund and it is to recognize a state grant for EMA. This grant has been received annually for the last several years. While the prior years amounts have averaged approximately \$4,960, this grant is for \$13,099 and was accepted by the Board of Commissioners at their regular meeting on May 5, 2009.
