Camden County Government Announces New Prescription Discount Card Enhanced Online Feature for All Residents *Discount Cards Can Now Be Printed Right From the Web*

Woodbine, GA (October 6, 2010) — Camden County Government is pleased to announce a new online feature for the NACo Prescription Discount Card Program that is already available to residents. Now county residents have the convenient option to print a card directly from the Web, for immediate use at any participating pharmacy.

“Camden County launched the program to help consumers cope with the high price of prescriptions. This enhancement provides easy access to the prescription discount card program for our residents that want to save money on prescriptions that are not covered by insurance,” said County Administrator Steve L. Howard. “Residents can print a card at their convenience, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.”

County residents can visit www.caremark.com/naco to print a live, personalized ID card and access other program tools. Savings are available immediately at any participating pharmacy.

Obtaining the card is easy, and to print a card:

1. Access www.caremark.com/naco and select “Print a card”
2. Utilize the map tool to enter the zip code or select the relevant state and county
3. Select next and the ID card is generated for printing
