County Commissioners Sworn In Chair and Vice-Chair Re-elected

WOODBINE, GEORGIA - January 6, 2015 – Commissioner Chuck Clark (District 2) and Commissioner Gary Blount (District 4) were sworn in by Probate Judge Robert C. Sweatt, Jr. in Woodbine this evening to begin their new four-year terms. Commissioner Clark represents the Harrietts Bluff area and the east side of Kingsland, while Commissioner Blount represents part of the City of St. Marys and southern Camden County. This will be Commissioner Clark's second term on the Board of County Commissioners, and Commissioner Blount's third term.

The Board elects the Chair and Vice-Chair of the County Commission each year and tonight, current Chairman of the Board, Commissioner Jimmy Starline, and Vice-Chair of the Board, Commissioner Chuck Clark, were both re-elected by their peers to serve another one-year term.

The Board of County Commissioners is comprised of five members elected through district elections for staggered, four-year terms. Their responsibilities include making policies, adopting laws, setting budget limits, and establishing tax rates. The Board also appoints a County Administrator and County Attorney, both of whom are chosen by and responsible to the Board of County Commissioners.

In addition, the Board sets an official regular meeting and holiday calendar prior to the upcoming year. Normally, meetings are held at 6:00 pm on the first and third Tuesday of each month unless otherwise scheduled due to conflicts. All meetings are held at the Government Services Complex, on the second floor, in the Commission Chambers located in Woodbine. Special Called meetings, Work Sessions, and Public Hearings are held when necessary. All meetings are open to the public.
