# Camden County Receives Grant for Interns

**WOODBINE, GEORGIA – February 21, 2018** – The Camden County Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce that it is a recipient of Georgia County Internship Program (GCIP) funds from the Association of County Commissioners of Georgia (ACCG). The \$3,000 grant will assist in funding two interns for summer 2018. One intern will work with the Camden County Sheriff's Office and one will work with the Camden County Emergency Management Agency (EMA).

"We are thrilled to receive this grant from ACCG," said Camden County Grants Manager Julie Haigler. "These interns will gain valuable experience and Camden County residents will benefit from their work."

This is the third consecutive year that Camden County has received this funding. Undergraduate and graduate level college students are encouraged to apply. **About Georgia County Internship Program (GCIP):** The Georgia County Internship Program (GCIP) offers first-hand internship experiences to undergraduate and graduate level college students in county government. Each summer, internships are offered across a broad spectrum of academic disciplines ranging from accounting to wildlife sciences in county government offices throughout the state. Created in 2010, with funding from the Georgia Department of Labor, to date, over 350 students have filled internship positions in 68 counties throughout the state.
